Jennifer Azzi Chief Business Development Officer for the Las Vegas Aces



Jennifer Azzi's achievements have firmly established her as one of the most accomplished figures in sports and business development. She has been inducted into eight halls of fame, including the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame. Jennifer is an Olympic Gold Medalist, Stanford NCAA National Champion, Two-Time World Champion, Naismith Award and Wade Trophy award winner, WNBA All-Star, and winner of the prestigious NCAA Silver Anniversary Award. Jennifer is a member of the USA Basketball Board of Directors.

Jennifer is the Chief Business Development Officer for the Las Vegas Aces, where she oversees all business development for the WNBA Championship franchise. Prior to joining the Aces, Jennifer served as Associate Vice President at the University of San Francisco, helping complete its largest Campaign in university history. Additionally, Jennifer was Head Coach for the University of San Francisco Women's Basketball team from 2010-2016. She led the program to its first NCAA tournament appearance in 20 years. Through her six seasons as Head Coach at the University of San Francisco, Azzi transformed the women's basketball program from arguably the worst program in the country into a bona fide postseason contender. In addition to her on court success, Azzi's program earned the NCAA's prestigious APR award for outstanding academic success. Only two programs in California won the honor-USF and Stanford. Her team finished the 2016 season with a 3.4 GPA.

Mike Davis moved to Las Vegas in 2019 to work as the Host/Reporter for "MORE" on FOX5 Las Vegas, the #1 rated entertainment/lifestyle show in Southern Nevada.

Born in Philadelphia and raised in South Jersey, Mike started performing stand-up comedy at the age of 17, working his way through open-mics to feature spots and headline gigs in high school. He then continued in college, while attending the University of Miami, consistently performing at the Miami Improv and various clubs throughout Ft. Lauderdale.

His experience on stage then led him to the screen, working as an actor in many short and indie-films, as well as commercial projects, including an international campaign for the BlackBerry Leap cellphone. After graduating magna cum laude from the University of Miami, with a focus in film and broadcast journalism, Mike moved to New York City to work for The Howard Stern Show. At SiriusXM studios he served as the Head Production Intern for Howard Stern, Robin Quivers, and Gary Dell'Abate.

Mike has also worked as a freelance sports reporter for NBC Sports Chicago and as a post-production assistant at NFL Films. In 2017, Mike graduated from the Medill School of Journalism at Northwestern University, earning his master's degree in broadcast journalism.

Mike began his career at KYTX CBS 19 in Tyler, Texas. There, he hosted the talk show, "19 Now," as well as co-anchored the weekday morning show, "The Morning Loop."

In 2019, Mike joined FOX5 Las Vegas. He served as a reporter/host for "MORE," the #1 entertainment show in Las Vegas. In addition, Mike contributed to FOX5 as a feature morning reporter and fill-in anchor. Mike also kickstarted production of the podcast studio, "The Den" at FOX5 where he hosts and produces, "Vegas Huddle," and "Dry Heat with Mike Davis."

In September 2023, Mike was offered a brand new position as a host and the first-ever employee of the "Silver State Sports & Entertainment Network." He's currently hosting and producing the fantasy football show, "The Fantasy G.O.A.T.," as well as the basketball show, "G League Ignite Takeover."
